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

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

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
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ULTIMATE SOURCE

the Nature of God

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
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WESTMINSTER CONFSSION

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
**JOHN 17:1-3**

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
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KNOWING ONLY?

that **exists** between God & man.

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

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
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SPURGEON'S PERSPECTIVE

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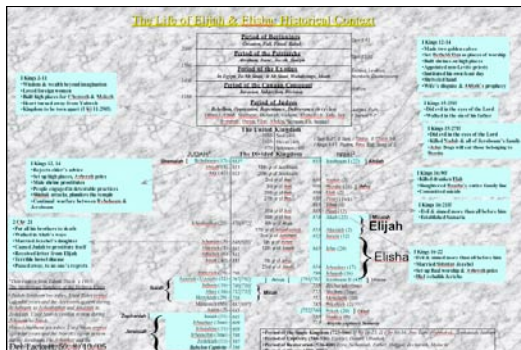
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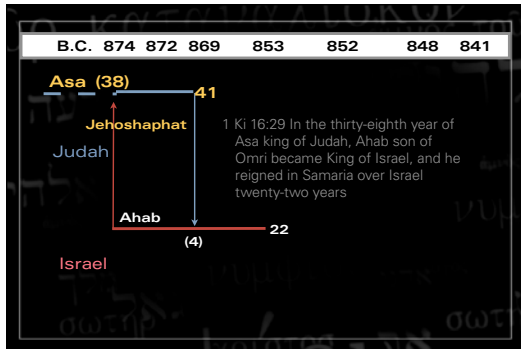
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## JORAM & JEHORAM 2 Kings 8:16 2 Kings 1:17

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### HOW TRUE IS THE BIBLE?

2 Ki 8:16-17 In the fifth year of Joram son of Ahab king of Israel, when Jehoshaphat was king of Judah, Jorhoram son of Jehosaphat began his reign as king of Judah. He was thirty-two years old when he became king, and he reigned in Jerusalem eight years.

2 Ki 1:17 So Ahaziah died, according to the word of the Lord that Elijah had spoken. Because Ahaziah had no son, Joram succeeded him as king in the second year of Jehoram son of Jehoshapat

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### HOW TRUE IS THE BIBLE?

2 Ki 3:1 Joram son of Ahab became king of Israel in Samaria in the eighteenth year of Jehosaphat king of Judah, and he reigned twelve years

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So, Jeroboam, who actually started to reign after Rehoboam, would be considered to be in his 3rd year when Rehoboam was still in his first year
